

Below is a *sample* four-year-plan that students may use as a rough guide for scheduling their time here at UC Davis. This schedule is not one that you should blindly follow; instead use it as a framework for your own, unique class schedule. Factors such as course choice (e.g. CHE 118 or CHE 8), AP credits, restricted electives, minors, professional goals, research, jobs, general education choices, and more will all influence your final schedule. Additionally, transfer students obviously do not require a four-year-plan and two-year-plans are extremely variable and will be unique to the student. **As always, we encourage you to make an appointment with our advisers and discuss your specific situation with them.
