Force Articulations:

When do I need to force articulate?

If you see any course you took listed as TR# in your UC Davis transcript/Oasis.

Ex. ENG TR1

What do I need to do?

Go to the UC Davis department that your class should articulate to.

What you need to bring:

- 1. Transcript/grade for the course
- 2. Course syllabus
- 3. Course schedule (if available)
- 4. UC Davis course that you think is its equivalent and its syllabus (if available)

What you need to do:

- 1. Take all of the above to the department
- 2. Go over everything with them. They may choose to send you to a professor that teaches the UC Davis equivalent
- 3. If approved, the department should notify the registrar who will change the course name in your UC Davis transcript/Oasis

Why do I need to do this?

For any courses you took at any school besides UC Davis and that you plan to use for your UC Davis degree, you must make sure they are listed as the UC Davis course equivalent in your UC Davis transcript/Oasis. We cannot certify your degree without this, so please check and do any force articulations as soon as possible!
